
Plug in 3 pin connector on Trueflex harness into Trueflex sensor.



Release wire routing sheath cap to route Trueflex harness safeley across motor.






















Route red wire coming from Truflex harness into the fuse box underneath the fuse block.







Using a flat head screwdriver, slide purple retainer up to allow access to ECU pins.

Insert blue wire pin from Trueflex harness into slot 45. Push in until you hear a click.






After inserting pin into ECU harness, slide purple retainer back into place to lock pins.




Making sure the lever is slid all the way out, replace cover on lower ECU plug.





Plug in ECU.

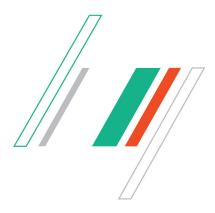


Plug Trueflex harness into Trueflex box and using the included double sided tape, mount Trueflex box to backside of driver headlight.
