

INCLUDED PARTS

- 01 FRONT SWAYBAR
- 02 SWAYBAR BUSHING (2X)
- 03 SWAYBAR MOUNT (2X)
- 04 M10 FLANGE NUT (4X)
- 05 GREASE FITTING
- 06 GREASE


Some items may be partially assembled.





Using a t25, remove 12 bolts holding up front undertray.

Using a 12 point 16mm socket and a 6 point 16mm socket, remove stock swaybar end link from stock mounting location.






Using a 16mm socket, remove swaybar mounts.




Remove stock swaybar from the vehicle.






Grease included swaybar bushings using the included grease packet.



Install bushings onto iE Swaybar on the outside of ridges on the swaybar. Place iE swaybar mounts onto bushings making sure to align grease fittings with holes on the bushings.

If you are reusing stock swaybar end links, skip to step 9. Adjust iE Swaybar End Link to match stock length. If you adjust to be shorter than stock, make sure at least 3/4" is threaded into end link body.



Using a 19mm wrench and the included tool to lock in end link height.



Install End Link onto swaybar before installing swaybar. Keep hand tight until fully installed.

Install swaybar onto stock mounting points using the included nuts. Using a 15mm socket and torque wrench, torque to 40-45ftlb.



Using the stock end link hardware, instal end link to stock mounting location. Make sure to orient bolt toward the outside of the vehicle. Tighten using a 12 point 16mm and 6 point 16mm.



Ensure that swaybar is adjusted so that it isn't touching the control arm at full droop. Tighten end link nuts.

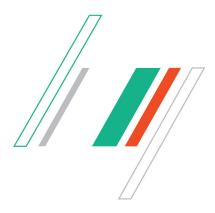


Reinstall undertray.
