




- 03 REAR SWAYBAR MOUNT (2X)
- 04 MOUNT PLATE (2X)
- 05 M8 SCREW (4X)
- 06 GREASE FITTING (2X)
- 07 GREASE

Some items may be partially assembled.









To remove the rear section of the exhaust make sure you have an extra set of hands or something to secure the exhuast so it doesn't fall.

Using a 13mm socket loosen exhaust hangers at the rear of the vehicle.







next two forward exhaust hangers.



Using a 13mm socket, loosen exhaust clamps.

Remove rear swaybar from vehicle.



Using included grease, grease the included swaybar bushings.



Using the stock swaybar for reference, install bushings onto the same location on the iE swaybar.






Install swaybar mounts onto previously installed bushings so that the grease fitting lines up with the hole on the bushing.



Using the swaybar mount backing plate, sandwich bushing between plate and swaybar mount. Make sure ridges are facing upward.








If you are installing iE Swaybar End links continue, if not, mount stock endlinks to iE Swaybar and mount using the same method as removal.


Adjust iE End Link to match stock length. If you adjust your end links shorter than stock, make sure at least 3/4" is threaded into end link.





Using the included wrench and a 19mm wrench, lock end link to adjusted height.




Install end link to stock mounting location. Make sure the bend is oriented toward the front of the vehicle to allow clearence for rear axles.
